The Municipal Aqueduct was built for the City of San Clemente in 1928. The structure is a remnant of the original Reservoir and Municipal Water Works and remains in use. This property appears eligible as a contributor to a potential National Register district under Criterion A for its association with the Ole Hanson/Spanish Village by the Sea period of development. It also appears eligible at the local level as a contributor to a potential historic district. It is recommended for addition to the Historic Structures List.

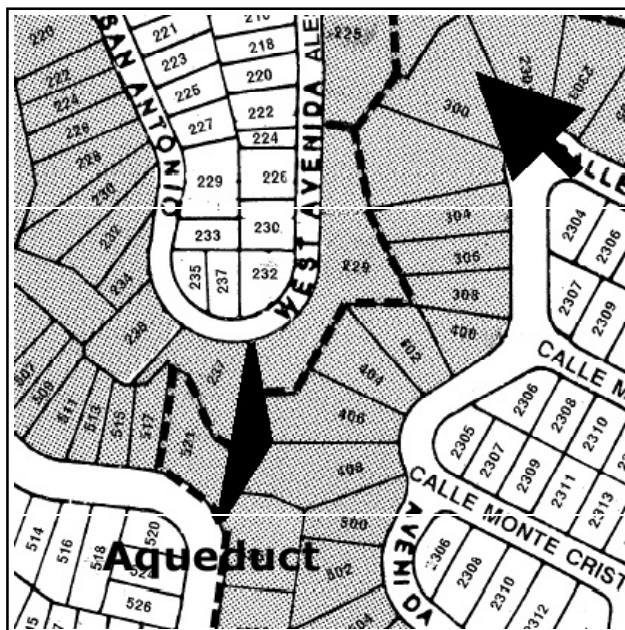
