P3a. Description:

The property contains a one-story single family residence with a rectangular plan and wood-frame construction. Designed in the Spanish Colonial Revival style, it has a low-pitch side-gable and front-gable roof with clay tiles and exposed rafter tails. There is a brick chimney. The exterior walls are clad with smooth stucco. The primary (east) facade is three bays wide. The northernmost bay is a one-car garage. The central bay contains a set of two 3-pane original wood casement windows. The southernmost bay is a recessed and covered entry porch. The fenestration consists of original wood casement windows throughout the residence. The residence is in good condition. Its integrity is good.

This one-story single-family residential building was built in 1928. According to local historian Marion Moon, this residence was built by Ole Hanson as his daughter's honeymoon house. This property is a typical example of the Spanish Colonial Revival style as represented in San Clemente. This property appears eligible as a contributor to a potential National Register district under Criterion A for its association with the Ole Hanson/Spanish Village by the Sea period of development. It also appears eligible at the local level as a contributor to a potential historic district. It is recommended for retention on/addition to the Historic Structures List.

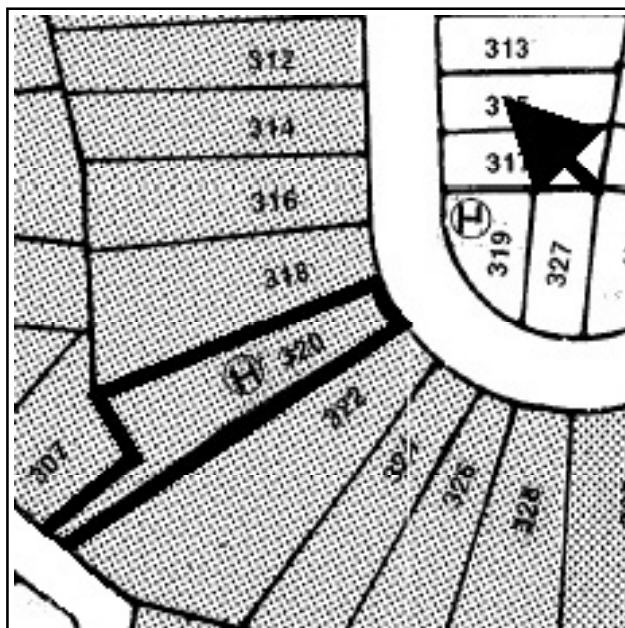
