The property contains a one-story single family residence with a rectangular plan and wood-frame construction. Designed in the Spanish Colonial Revival style, it has a medium pitch front-gable roof with clay tiles and exposed rafter tails. The exterior walls are clad with stucco. A shed roof covers the entryway on Miramar, while a covered entryway is on the Ola Vista facade of the residence. Decorative features of the Spanish Colonial Revival style include exposed rafter tails, a stucco chimney, and a low stucco wall that encloses a courtyard. The fenestration consists of non-original but compatible wood windows throughout the residence. The residence is in good condition. Its integrity is good.


