

P3a. Description:

The property contains a two-story multiple family residence with a rectangular plan and wood-frame construction. Designed in the Spanish Colonial Revival style, it has a low-pitch front-gable and hip roof clad with clay tiles. The exterior walls are clad with smooth stucco. The residence includes low stucco walls at the perimeter of the property. Spanish Colonial Revival elements include a stucco chimney, exposed rafter tails and projecting roof beams. The fenestration is symmetrically-arranged and is comprised of original divided-light wood casement and fixed windows throughout the residence. The doors of the residence are not original. The residence is in good condition. Its integrity is good.

This two-story multiple- family residence was built for Clarence J. Munchow in 1929. The property was originally constructed to serve as housing for the Pacific Coast League's Seattle Indians baseball team during Spring Training in 1930s. This property is one of the few multiple-family residences from the period, and is a rare example of the Spanish Colonial Revival style applied to a multi-family residence in San Clemente. This property appears eligible as a contributor to a potential National Register district under Criterion A for its association with the Ole Hanson/Spanish Village by the Sea period of development. It also appears eligible at the local level as a contributor to a potential historic district. It is recommended for retention on the Historic Structures List.


