#### P3a. Description:

The property contains a one-story single family residence with a rectangular plan and wood-frame construction. Built prior to 1955, the residence was relocated to the site in that year. Designed in the Spanish Colonial Revival style, the main mass of the residence is under a medium-pitch front-gable roof with clay tiles, while the primary (north) elevation is under a medium-pitch side-gable roof with clay tiles. The portion of the side-gable roof over the entryway extends to cover an entrance porch including wood porch supports and a wood balustrade. The eastern bay of the primary elevation projects slightly from the main mass of the building and features a medium-pitch front-gable roof with clay tiles. Centered under the bay's gable is a rounded arch wood-slat vent, and below is a nearly full-height rounded arch fixed window. The exterior walls are clad with original smooth stucco. The fenestration consists of original wood double-hung windows on the side elevation and original wood fixed windows on the front elevation. The residence features an entry porch with wood balustrades and wood porch supports. The residence also includes a decorative stucco chimney with a high-pitch clay tile cap centered on the east elevation and porte cochere off of the west elevation punctuated with square stucco capped piers. A low stucco wall capped with bricks runs along the driveway. The residence is in good condition. Its integrity is good.


